"HUMAN TRAFFICKING"**

SOROR PATRICIA A. DANIELS AND SOROR YVONNE OWENS:

- **HUMAN TRAFFICKING IS THE MODERN-DAY SLAVERY.**
- **DOMESTIC VIOLENCE IS A PATTERN OF BEHAVIOR, ONE OF THE GREATEST UNREPORTED CRIMES.**
- **SEXUAL ASSAULT = AN ACT INCLUDING HARASSMENT, RAPE, IMPROPER TOUCHING.**
- **HUMAN TRAFFICKING IS A "HIDDEN CRIME". LOOKING FOR THOSE WHO ARE VULNERABLE SUCH AS ISOLATION, CHANGE IN BEHAVIOR, SUBMISSIVE, DENIED FOOD, AND LACK OF PERSONAL POSSESSIONS, TO NAME A FEW.**
- **THERE IS ALSO SPIRITUAL ABUSE.**
- **IT'S A \$32 BILLION INDUSTRY.**
- **800,000 TO 4 MILLION ARE TRAFFIC EVERY YEAR MOSTLY, EAST ASIAN AND THE PACIFIC REGION.**
- **THE "BLUE" RIBBON REPRESENTS THAT CAUSE.**

THE FEDERAL DEFINITION OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING IS:

(A) sex trafficking in which a commercial sex act is induced by force, fraud, or coercion, or in which the person induced to perform such act has not attained 18 years of age; or
(B) the recruitment, harboring, transportation, provision, or obtaining of a person for labor or services, through the use of force, fraud, or coercion for the purpose of subjection to involuntary servitude, peonage, debt bondage, or slavery.
